The Town of Clint will receive bids for reconstruction of Langford Street until 2:00 PM MST on Tuesday, June 10, 2025 in person at Clint Town Hall, 200 San Elizario Road, Clint, TX, or by mail to the Town of Clint at P.O. Box 350, Clint, Tx 79836. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 PM MST on Tuesday, June 10, 2025 at Clint Town Hall, 200 San Elizario Road, Clint, Texas.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

1. Insurance, Bonds and Move-In Relates Expenses, Not to Exceed 5%
2. Remove and Dispose of Existing Asphalt Pavement
3. 2" HMA TY D
4. 6" Flexible Base
5. Prime Coat
6. Traffic Control
7. Earthwork/ Prep. Surface
8. Concrete Header Curb
9. Saw/Cut, Remove and Dispose of Existing Concrete
10. Furnish and Install Reflective Pavement Marking
11. Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan
12. Match Existing Water Valves/Manhole Elevations

A certified check or bank draft payable to the Town of Clint or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing Davis-Bacon and Related Acts wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.

The Town of Clint reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the Town of Clint for a period not to exceed 30 / 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.

All contractors and subcontractors must be cleared not suspended or debarred prior to any formal action authorizing the award of a contract to the contractor. Minority Business Enterprises, Small Business Enterprises, Women Business Enterprises, and Section 3 Businesses are encouraged to submit bids.
